CHALLENGE

The site for this new church was chosen for its superior view from atop a hill. However, due to location, wind became a factor that added challenges to the project. Multiple roof sections with several angles also added to the complexity.

UNIQUE ISSUES

- ▲ Extreme weather conditions
- ▲ Windows of unusual sizes and angles
- ▲ Over 200 pieces of insulating glass
- ▲ Majority of windows feature custom patterned shapes
- ▲ 16 doors with unique configurations

SOLUTION

For this structure to be completed on time, Tri City Glass & Door put in the necessary hours (including weekends) to meet deadlines, even while windy days caused extra challenges. Special booms were used to lift windows over the steeply pitched roofs. Custom windows and doors were designed to fit exactly into the openings specified by the architect. Sixteen doors with unique configurations were all custom made. Working together, the team responsible for building this church created a breathtaking haven ideal for reflection and worship. **Tri City Glass & Door was awarded the "Project of Distinction Award" by Associated Builders & Contractors of Wisconsin in 1998 for their work on the St. Mary's Catholic Community Church.**



PRODUCTS USED

- ▲ Glass: Gray low-e insulated glass windows
- ▲ Framing: Bronze anodized aluminum window and door frames
- ▲ Doors: Pine Crest solid oak doors
- ▲ Hardware: Special hardware for high-traffic
